What We Build

Environmental Intelligence

We develop systems that bring weather and environmental information together into interfaces that are easier to use and understand.

This includes technologies involving:

- Weather observations
- Forecast information
- Interactive radar
- Severe-weather alerts
- Environmental information
- Air-quality information
- Camera networks
- Geographic information
- Field observations
- Public safety information

Our primary environmental intelligence initiative is **ENID Weather**.

Data Platforms

Modern information is often distributed across many different systems, agencies, providers, databases, and formats.

Plaza Development Group develops platforms designed to organize that information into useful digital experiences.

Depending on the project, this may include:

- Data aggregation
- Search and discovery
- Mapping
- API-based information systems
- Database development
- Historical records
- Public-facing dashboards
- Administrative systems
- Status and monitoring systems
- Cross-platform applications

Our goal is to turn large amounts of information into interfaces people can actually use.

Networking & Connected Systems

Networking is a core part of the technology behind many Plaza Development Group projects.

Our platforms may connect websites, APIs, databases, mobile applications, servers, external information providers, sensor networks, cameras, mapping services, and other systems into a unified platform.

Reliable communication between those systems is essential to delivering useful information to the people who depend on it.

Featured Projects

ENID Weather

Environmental Network Insight Data

ENID Weather is Plaza Development Group's environmental intelligence and weather technology platform.

ENID is designed to bring multiple types of weather and environmental information together within a single ecosystem.

Instead of requiring users to move between numerous individual sources, ENID provides a central interface for accessing weather and situational information.

ENID Weather includes capabilities involving:

Weather Forecasts

Access current conditions and forecast information through a streamlined weather interface.

Interactive Weather Radar

View radar information designed to help users understand the location and movement of precipitation and storms.

Weather Alerts

Access active watches, warnings, severe-weather information, and other public weather notices.

Camera Networks

View available traffic, transportation, weather, and environmental camera information from supported providers.

Air Quality

Access environmental and air-quality information where data is available.

Weather News

Bring relevant weather and environmental information from supported information sources into one platform.

Storm-Chasing & Field Operations

ENID includes tools designed for authorized field operations and weather observation, including the ability to work with radar, GPS information, observations, and storm-session information.

Emergency Information

ENID provides access to emergency-related tools and information intended to help users quickly locate important resources during severe weather or other urgent situations.

One Environmental Information Ecosystem

The long-term vision behind ENID Weather goes beyond displaying a basic forecast.

Weather information can originate from radar systems, government alerts, environmental networks, transportation cameras, field observations, forecast providers, and many other sources.

ENID is being developed as an information layer capable of bringing these resources together.

The result is an expanding environmental intelligence platform intended for:

- Members of the public
- Weather enthusiasts
- Storm spotters
- Storm chasers
- Researchers
- Field personnel
- Organizations needing consolidated weather information

ENID Data Transparency

Plaza Development Group believes weather applications should be clear about what they know—and what they do not know.

ENID Weather is designed around a simple principle:

Unavailable information should remain unavailable rather than being invented.

Weather, radar, cameras, alerts, configuration information, and application updates may originate from the ENID platform and supported external providers.

When information cannot be retrieved, ENID may identify information as unavailable or indicate when cached information is being displayed.

This approach helps users distinguish between current information, previously retrieved information, and unavailable information.

GLCAD

Great Lakes Crime Avoidance Database

GLCAD — the Great Lakes Crime Avoidance Database — is another Plaza Development Group project.

GLCAD represents Plaza Development Group's broader interest in developing data-driven systems that organize publicly useful information and make complex datasets easier to understand.

The project is separate from ENID Weather and focuses on information relevant to crime awareness and avoidance.

As the platform develops, additional information about its capabilities, geographic coverage, data practices, methodology, and availability can be published through the official GLCAD project website.

Our Development Philosophy

Information Should Be Understandable

A database containing millions of records has limited value if users cannot understand what those records mean.

We focus on interfaces that translate complex information into understandable tools, maps, dashboards, alerts, and applications.

Information Should Be Traceable

Whenever practical, platforms should identify where information originates.

Government agencies, public datasets, transportation agencies, environmental providers, and other third parties may remain the authoritative source for information displayed through Plaza Development Group platforms.

Aggregation does not replace the original source.

Missing Data Should Not Become Invented Data

When a source is unavailable, applications should communicate that limitation.

Plaza Development Group does not believe unavailable information should be silently replaced with fabricated information simply to make an interface appear complete.

Security Is Part of Development

Modern applications require more than a polished interface.

Plaza Development Group considers security throughout the development and operation of its platforms, including areas such as:

- Authentication
- Access control
- Administrative permissions
- Data protection
- System logging
- Software updates
- Infrastructure monitoring
- Backups and recovery
- Responsible handling of sensitive information

No technology system can promise absolute security, but security should remain an ongoing part of system design and maintenance.

Public Safety & Responsible Use

Some Plaza Development Group projects provide information related to weather, emergencies, transportation conditions, environmental conditions, or public safety.

These platforms are intended to **supplement—not replace—official emergency services and authoritative government information.**

Users should always follow instructions issued by:

- Emergency management agencies
- The National Weather Service
- NOAA
- Law enforcement
- Fire departments
- Emergency medical services
- Transportation authorities
- Other appropriate government agencies

When immediate police, fire, or medical assistance is required, users should contact the appropriate emergency service directly.

Technology can improve access to information. It cannot eliminate the need for human judgment or official emergency response.

Privacy

Privacy considerations are particularly important when technology interacts with information such as location, account information, device information, or field observations.

Plaza Development Group platforms should collect and retain information only as necessary for their intended functionality and according to the privacy documentation applicable to each service.

Individual Plaza Development Group projects may maintain their own:

- Privacy Policy
- Terms & Conditions
- Safety Documentation
- Data-retention policies
- Support information
- Service-specific disclosures

Visitors should review the policies associated with the individual platform they are using.

Third-Party Information

Plaza Development Group services may display or process information supplied by external organizations, government agencies, public datasets, APIs, camera operators, mapping providers, weather providers, or other third parties.

Ownership and responsibility for third-party information remain with the respective source where applicable.

Availability, accuracy, update frequency, and geographic coverage can vary by provider.

Plaza Development Group does not control every external information source used by its platforms.

Availability

Internet-connected services can occasionally become unavailable because of:

- Internet outages
- Provider outages
- Maintenance
- Severe weather
- Infrastructure failures
- API interruptions
- Device connectivity
- Geographic limitations
- Third-party service disruptions

For this reason, no Plaza Development Group service should be treated as the sole source of critical emergency information.

Platform Development

Plaza Development Group develops technology for multiple platforms and environments.

Depending on the individual project, technologies may include:

- Mapping systems
- Administrative platforms

Our platforms continue to evolve as new capabilities, information providers, devices, and use cases become available.

Research & Development

Some technologies may remain experimental while others progress into publicly available services.

Project availability, functionality, geographic coverage, supported platforms, and development schedules may change as systems evolve.
